

Spirit of the Morning



An absorbing exposition of Uluru's (Ayers Rock) natural history and deep significance to the Aboriginal people.

This is a vehicle based version of the Uluru Walk. This tour to Uluru provides the opportunity to witness the spectacular sunrise without rushing, all the while absorbing an exposition of Uluru's natural history and deep significance to the

Anangu people. Short walks will bring you close to this wonderful and powerful place, viewing rock art, waterholes and appreciating the unique flora and fauna of Uluru. A special feature is the appreciation of the exquisite as well as the dramatic sculpturing of Uluru. This tour provides time to amble, to absorb images and to gain an insight into Uluru's remarkable presence. The final step is to the Uluru and Kata Tjuta Cultural Centre.

- 4 hour guided and vehicle based tour around Uluru.
- Includes sunrise viewing, picnic breakfast and visit to the Uluru - Kata Tjuta Cultural Centre
- Short walks at Uluru
- Pick up and return from all resort accommodation.

Uluru Walk

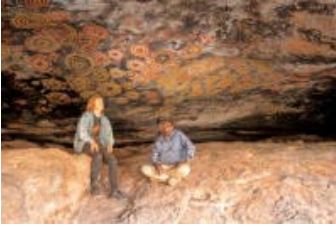


For Uluru this is the most comprehensive tour that provides an opportunity to best understand the natural and cultural significance of Uluru. The **Uluru Walk** tour commences prior to sunrise and places you in the most grand and deeply moving places. During this 9.4km (or 6 mile) amble, you will be introduced to the geology of Uluru and to the plants and wildlife that have adapted and survived in such a forbidding environment. But most fascinating is the relationship of the

Anangu people to Uluru. This place was shelter, provided water and is a tangible link with their creation ancestors. As you walk around the base you will hear and see the creation time stories of these ancient people unfold. See where the people lived and carried out ceremonies. Here, the beliefs of the people are embodied in one of the great places of this world. From a distance Uluru is spectacular; from close up it is powerful and deeply moving.

- 5 hour guided walking tour around the base of Uluru. A reasonable level of fitness is required.
- Sunrise viewing and picnic breakfast included.
- Pick up and return from all resort accommodation.

Cave Tour



Depart by 4WD through bush tracks directly through the arid desert and into the Pitjantjatjara Lands. You will be met by Anangu hosts and teachers at Cave Hill, the site of the Seven Sisters Tjukurpa. This Songline crosses the width and breadth of the Australian continent. The main feature is the magnificent cave paintings - possibly the most significant art site in Central Australia. The drama of the Seven Sisters creation story is graphically illustrated on the ceiling of the cave. Discuss Tjukurpa (dreaming) and learn about the Songlines and its relevance to Anangu life in the desert. Includes:

- Anangu guides.
- Permits and park entry fees.
- Morning tea and lunch
- Pick up and return from all resort accommodation.

Kata Tjuta and Dunes



The **Kata Tjuta and Dunes** tour introduces you to the Central Australian arid desert. Leaving mid-afternoon, the guide will explain the nature of the desert and its development. A short walk to the dune lookout puts you in touch with your environment and lets you delight in the spectacular panoramic view of Kata Tjuta, a very sacred place to the Aboriginal people. Arriving at Walpa Gorge you walk into this mystic place, to hear how it has evolved over millions of years. The scale of the walls and the wind far above, add a sense of mystery here, which profoundly affects all that participate. The sky blue deepens and the great domes of Kata Tjuta flush red as the tour retires to the sunset viewing area to celebrate the fantastic color changes wrought by the sunset with the complimentary champagne. Sit back and absorb the desert solitude or relax and chat to your guide about Australia's Red Centre. The spectacle fades as you return to Yulara beneath a sky of brilliant stars.
