Kangaroo Island, Australia

Island Life Tour

At Seal Bay Conservation Park walk with your guide among Australian sea lions lounging on their beautiful sandy beach. Watch pups nursing, or playing in the surf, see old bulls bearing the scars of territorial disputes and learn about their unique breeding biology. Break for lunch and enjoy a delicious meal featuring King George whiting, fresh salads and fine South Australian wines. Where? At a private bush location.

Flinders Chase Focus Tour

Explore The Remarkable Rocks, huge natural granite sculptures, that have been carved by relentless winds, rain and salt from the Southern Ocean. Drive down to Cape du Couedic taking in some dramatic dune country along the road that follows the original horse trail between the ranger station and the lighthouse settlement on the tip of the peninsula. See the beautiful stone lighthouse where three light keepers and their families lived, maintaining a warning for ships. Finish the day with a visit to "Grassdale" in the heart of Kelly Hill Conservation Park, the home of the pioneering Edwards Family and now a great place for kangaroo observation. Break for a picnic lunch featuring local produce and good wines.



Stranraer Homestead

Stranraer is a historic homestead that was built in 1920 from limestone gathered on the property. It is a working sheep

farm and offers an outstanding glimpse of the real Kangaroo Island lifestyle. Lyn and Graham Wheaton host you for two nights at their traditional bed and breakfast. They send you out to discover the wonders of their island home and welcome you back to recharge for another day of Exceptional Kangaroo Island.

Regional Express Air provides the most convenient travel to Kangaroo Island from Adelaide (35 minutes with no stops). Flights in the morning or mid to late afternoon are scheduled to coordinate with the island tours.

Deposit/Acceptance

A **\$400** per person minimum non-refundable deposit is required to begin requesting and holding land bookings. Payment of deposit and or partial payment and or full payment constitutes acceptance of all terms listed in this agreement and on your itinerary.

Flights: Airline reservations are in addition to land reservations and must be paid in full at time of ticketing. Discover Downunder cannot be held responsible for name spelling or birthdate errors if we have not received copies of passports prior to ticketing. Additional Fees are to be borne by the traveler.

Final Payment

Full payment is due *no later than* **60** days prior to departure. Some services may require earlier payment; you will be advised of this. Prices are subject to change until **full** payment has been received by Discover Downunder. If payment has not been received 60 days prior to departure, booking is subject to late fees and will delay delivery of documents. All arrangements will be re-checked and final travel documents are scheduled to be electronically delivered <u>14 days prior to departure</u>. A **\$75** fee will be charged for returned checks. Personal checks will not be accepted for payment within **16** days of departure.

Amendments

An amendment is any change, addition or cancellation. After confirmation has been received, a \$15 per item amendment fee applies each time an itinerary is amended in addition to any price changes. After documents have been prepared, and for amendments made within 30 days prior to departure, a minimum \$30 per item amendment fee applies in addition to any price changes.

Insurance

All travelers are **strongly urged** to purchase adequate <u>Travel Insurance</u> to protect against cancellation/changes for whatever reason prior to or during travel. Refer to **Cancellation**. Many travel insurance options include additional benefits such as covering **pre-existing conditions** when purchasing a policy within **7 days of deposit**.

Cancellation

A minimum \$400 charge per person **plus** any charges levied by airlines and suppliers will be incurred if there is a cancellation after bookings have begun. Certain airfares and properties and operators have higher cancellation penalties; these will be assessed at the time of cancellation. Cancellations beginning **60 days prior to** departure or after final payment has been made, will incur a 100% cancellation fee. Cancellations after departure date, will incur a 100% cancellation fee. *Please refer to the section: Insurance, to avoid further disappointment.*

Pricing

Unless noted, all pricing is listed in US\$. Prices are contracted for in advance and may be subject to currency fluctuations, changes in local taxes and increases by suppliers. While every effort is made to keep prices highly competitive; we have no control over local specials and in-country discounts that may be available for limited periods of time.
